

## Understanding your new office visit benefit.

Effective May 1<sup>st</sup> 2011



Jane Doe visits her doctor and has an office visit. The examples below reflect how the office visit benefit is provided with the new "full benefit amount". Even if the charge is less than the benefit, the provider is paid and then any difference is sent directly to the policyholder.

### Prior Benefit
